Why not consider joining like-minded Triumph aficionados for an enjoyable week-end of driving and showing off our LBCs at this year's 28th Canadian Classic event.

The weekend will be spent in the relaxing atmosphere of the scenic Grand River Valley with the charm of its old mill towns including Fergus and Elora, the antique covered bridge at West Montrose, and the traditional Mennonite country north of St. Jacob's.

Situated only an hour's drive southwest of Toronto, the Grand River is the largest river in south-western Ontario. From its source near Wareham, it flows south through Grand Valley, via Fergus, Elora, Waterloo, Kitchener, Cambridge, Paris, Brantford, Caledonia and Cayuga before discharging into the north shore of Lake Erie at Port Maitland. The river's rural character, ease of access and lack of portages make it a favourite canoeing destination, especially the stretch between West Montrose and Paris.

The Mohawk name for the Grand River, *O:se Kenhionhata:tie* means "Willow River". The river was named *Grande Rivière* by the French during the 18th century. It was later renamed Ouse River by John Graves Simcoe for the Great Ouse River near his childhood home in Lincolnshire. The anglicised form of the French name has remained in common usage.
